



Utah Arabian Horse Club – High Point Awards The Procedure and The Rules (30Jan2009)

ELIGIBILITY TO RECEIVE AN AWARD

- To be eligible the owner and rider/handler/driver must be a member of the UAHC by close of the Utah Valley Show.
- To be eligible to receive an award participation is required:
 1. Halter/Side Saddle: Participation in that disciplined class at the UAHC Spring and Fall Show required to be eligible to receive a High Point award in that division.*
 2. Open Awards/ Reigning : Must Participate at the UAHC Spring and Fall Show and One of the following: UABHA Charity Show or UABHA State Fair. *
 3. Adult Amateur & Junior Amateur Awards: Must Participate at the UAHC Spring and Fall Show and Two of the following: UABHA Charity Show, UAHC Amateur Show, UABHA State Fair.*
 4. Sport Horse in Hand: Must participate in all the UAHC Sport Horse Sponsored Shows. (In the event of a tie-breaker winner will be determined by the horses individual score in the class the higher winning the award)

*To be eligible to receive a high point award you must compete in that discipline at each point earning show. Example: To Receive the Arabian Western pleasure award you must compete in Western Pleasure classes at that point earning show to receive points.

- If no one horse or rider fits the qualifications No High Point Award Will Be Given.

POINT AWARD SYSTEM

- The UAHC will be using the system set up by AHA
In a 7 Horse Class the Points will be Distributed as follows:
 - 1st Place – 7 Points
 - 2nd Place – 6 Points
 - 3rd Place – 5 Points
 - 4th Place – 4 Points
 - 5th Place – 3 Points

6th Place – 2 Points

- For UABHA shows substitute OPEN classes for similar Arabian classes if and only if there is no Arabian Class Available. (*by way of example: If there is Open Hunter AOTR and there is also Arabian Hunter AOTR, Then the Open Hunter AOTR placing WILL NOT receive points. Only the Arabian Hunter AOTR will count towards the High Point Award. If trail is offered as an open class and there is no Arabian trail class, the placing in the open class will count towards the high point award for that class.*)
- Open (As in all-breed) classes will count toward Amateur Points if of no amateur class is offered.

TIEBREAKER CRITERIA

In the event of a tie (two candidates have the same number of points after the points form all show have been recorded) the following tiebreakers will apply in the order listed.

1. Point Placing at the UAHC Spring and Fall Show will take Precedence.
2. In head-to-head competition (meaning only those shows where both competed) which competitor beat whom the most times.
3. If still tied after this, both will be awarded a high-point award.

UTAH ARABIAN HORSE CLUB – HIGH POINT AWARDS A PROCEDURE AND REWARD INSTRUCTION GUIDEBOOK

There will be a minimum of two administrators making up the high-point award committee, a primary and a back up to ensure the process is staffed. The High Point Award Committee will be considered a standing committee of the UAHC and will report to a board appointed sponsor.

The show secretary is to provide show results within **ten days** of the completion of the show to the High Point Award administrator.

A final audit will be conducted by the Board at the October/November Board meeting to ensure accuracy and that all eligibility rules have been fulfilled. The audited awards will be presented at the November meeting for approval by the board.

FUNDING

Funding for the High Point Awards will be decided by the board following the close of the Autumn Classic. If more than one award is won by one individual, that individual will be contacted and give the option to receive cash equal to the amount of the award given.
